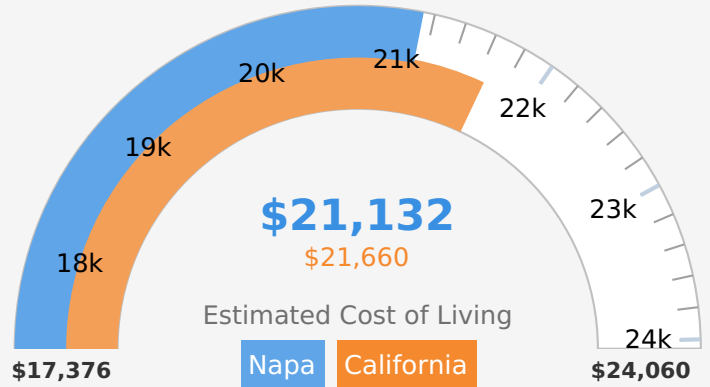

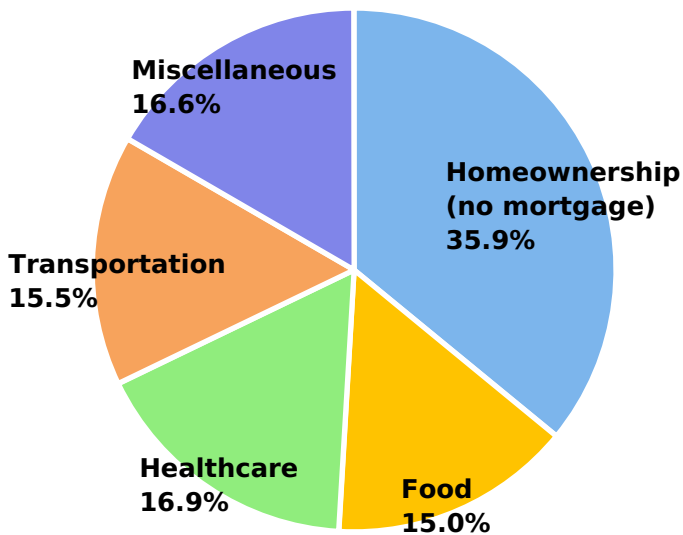
The estimated annual basic cost of living in 2019 for a household with a Single Elder in Napa is **\$21,132***, which is **2.5% lower** than the California average. That breaks down to a total cost of **\$1,761/month**.

This estimate takes into account the cost of housing, food, healthcare, transportation, and other miscellaneous expenses.

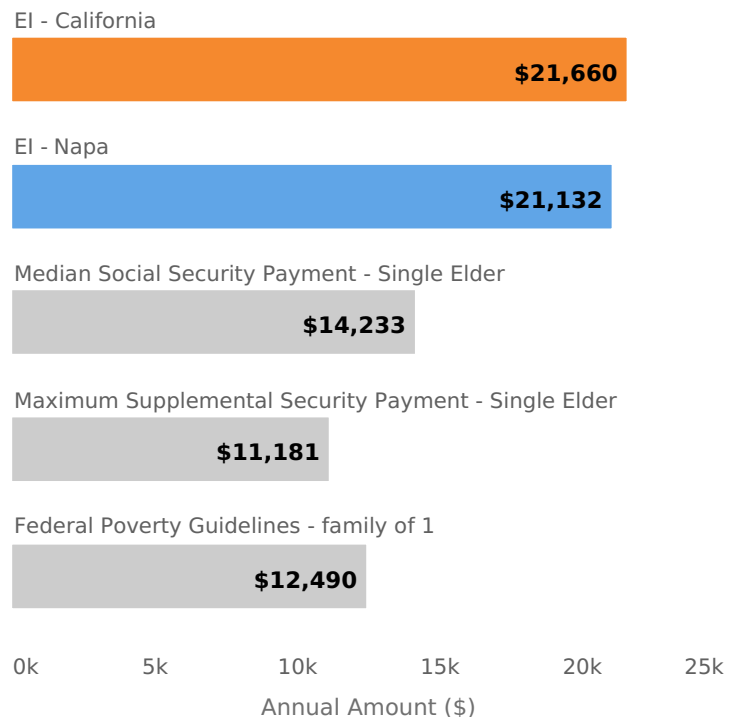


*Household includes **a Single Elder** housing **no adult children** and **no grandchildren**. Head of household is an **older adult** who **owns a home without a mortgage**.
